We are very thankful to God and to every one who allow us in the Valley of Hope to start with the goat project. It is working very well and we start to spread it with some other people in the community of Bernard Galette Chambon. I received last week the goat project report from our goat supervisor. We have now a total of 70 female goats. They already give 39 babies. Six of the babies were males; we sell them and buy females.

For now we have 39 new people in the project. Those received each of them a female baby goat. The number of people having goat now is 109.



Since November 2013, we started with a chicken's project. We had 300 chickens that we gave to the women in the church to sell so that they can have some income for themselves and also we can continue to buy new chickens. Now we have 300 again and they will be ready to sell in 15 days.
